Read Ezekiel 10

1. What does Ezekiel see and hear in 10:1-9?

2. What order does the Lord give to the man clothed in linen (10:2)? What do you think the coals represent (See Genesis 19:24; Amos 7:4)? What do you think his actions accomplish?

3. To what does the text compare the appearance and sound of the cherubim? What aspects of God's nature are implied through these images?

4. What happens in 10:18-19, and what is the significance of this?

5. What is compared to the Old Testament Temple in 1 Corinthians 3:16? What are some ways the warning in Ezekiel 10 about what was going to happen to the Old Testament Temple can be applied to our situation?

Read Ezekiel 11

6. Ezekiel is given a vision of 25 leaders by the gate to the temple. What kind of leadership have the men at the beginning of chapter 11 been giving in Jerusalem? (11:1-12)
7. Have you experienced the loss and disappointment of seeing a Christian leader you trusted fall or fail in some way? What were the effects of that event – on you, on others?
8. What does God say that Israel is guilty of in 11:5-12? What punishment does he pronounce?
9. What happens in 11:13? What insight do we gain about Ezekiel's spiritual life from this? What does his response teach us about our own approach to sharing God's message?
10. What hopeful message does the Lord have for the people scattered in Babylon (11:14-21)?
11. What does Ezekiel see and experience in 11:22-25?
