Rest From the Burdens

Rev. F.E. Hoskins tells of an experience on the slopes of Lebanon on a hot afternoon in August as a group of men engaged in the task of gathering thorns from the rocky mountainside. These thorns would be burned in the lime kilns on the mountain slopes because of a lack of trees and other materials to burn. The thorns were rolled into huge bales, about half as large as a cartload of hay, and then carried to the kilns. No more trying, unattractive occupation could be conceived of than the cutting, handling and carrying of these dusty dry particles on that waterless slope under the blazing Syrian sun.

While thinking that such toil was almost more than any human should have to endure, Rev. Hoskins' attention was attracted to one of the thorn bundles sitting by the side of the road, and in its shade lay the thorn gatherer, asleep in the shadow of his burden.

What a challenge to us today. We need to learn to drop our burden for a while and rest in its shadow. In the book of Exodus, Israel found rest from her burdens. God removed from their shoulders the burdens which had been theirs under the ruthless Pharaoh, and they no longer had to produce bricks for the Egyptians. He turned back the waters of the Red Sea for their escape on dry ground, provided for their needs as they crossed the wilderness and brought them to the Promised Land.

Beloved, in Christ our burdens have been removed and we can know real rest. "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). Praise His name!
